- Latin American Twentieth-Century Pamphlets.** Total of 233 reels.  
 This collection is published in three part. Each part can also be ordered separately.  
**Part 1: The Southern Cone.** Argentina, Chile, Paraguay and Uruguay are included in this part. 1,408 pamphlets on 49 reels (43,826 images)  
**Part 2: Central America and the Caribbean.** Some of the countries included are Haiti, Cuba, Mexico and Jamaica. 1,603 pamphlets on 75 reels (53,910 images)  
**Part 3: Brazil, Bolivia, Colombia, Ecuador, Peru, Venezuela, Guyana, and Suriname.** 2,036 pamphlets on 109 reels (82,370 images)
- Latin American Anarchist and Labour Periodicals (c. 1880-1940)**  
 The bulk of the material (collected by the Austrian anarchist and historian Max Nettlau) covers the formative anarchist and anarcho-syndicalist period in the history of Latin American labour movements (1890-1920). 108 reels.
- Early Printed Books on Religion from Colonial Spanish America (1543/4- c.1800)**  
 Holdings of the British Library. Printing in colonial Spanish America began early. During the colonial period, the publishing output in Spanish America was dominated by doctrinal and devotional works, confessionals, hymnals and saints' lives. The British Library collection comprises more than 400 works from this period, the majority of which are from Mexico and Peru. Titles 406. 1038 Microfiches.
- Comintern Archives: Files of the Communist Party of Mexico, 1919-1940.**  
 The Comintern ruled over the international Communist movement through its seventy partner organizations in Europe, Asia, America and Africa for almost a quarter of a century (1919 -1943). The files of the Communist Party of Mexico cover the period 1919-1940, and include extensive documentation of relations between the Comintern and its counterparts in Mexico and other countries in Latin America. Many documents in this collection are unique. 29 reels.
