- **Iranian opposition to the Shah.** Publications about Iran of an anti-Pahlavi nature, published outside Iran between 1962 and 1979. The documents comprise all of the important primary sources (transactions of congresses, defense pleas, party programs) as well as literature on economics, guerilla movements, human rights, Islamic government and revolution, minorities, political trials, prisons, religion, sociology, and the Tudeh Party. 27 titles. 747 microfiche.
- **Historical Photographs of the Middle East.** A selection of photographs dated between 1858 and 1973 from the photo archive in the Middle East Centre of St. Antony's College, Oxford. The collection documents political, historical, archaeological and anthropological events and subjects in the Middle East. 16,122 photographs. 194 microfiche.
- **Arabic Newspapers and Periodicals**
Palestine Newspapers: Among some of the titles are al-Anbā' 50 reels, Al-Difā 57 reels, al-Fajr 66 reels, el-Carmel 8 reels, al-Fajr- The Dawn 13 reels. Total number of titles: 55, 3,831 fiche and 4,727 reels.
Egyptian Oppositional Periodicals: Among some of the titles are al-Twahid 54 microfiche, al-Tasawwuf al-Islāmi 34 microfiche and al-Dawa 77 microfiche. Total number of titles 5 and 233 fiche.
Early Arabic Periodicals: Among some of the titles are al-Muqtabas 52 microfiche, al-Nibrās 10 microfiche, al-Sā'ih 9 microfiche and al-Zahrā 39 microfiche. Total number of titles 5 and 212 microfiche.

- **Creation of Modern Saudi Arabia.** The archives of the Political and Secret Department of the India Office are an outstanding source for the history of the Saudi state. This is the first time the major files have been made available in their entirety in one series. The material in this collection consists of confidential printed reports, maps, memoranda, and hand books, together with Political and Secret Department policy files describing the wider context of international relations, as well as the practical details of an expanding political administration and social and economic infrastructure. 778 microfiche.
- **Creation of Modern Iraq, c. 1914-1921.** The geopolitical identity of present-day Iraq can be traced back to the British Military occupation of the First World War and the civil administration established at the beginning of the British Mandate, which lasted from 1921 until independence in 1932. The materials in this collection consist of India Office Political & Secret Department confidential reports, memoranda, maps, and handbooks, as well as policy files describing the background and practicalities of the creation of a political administration, as well as of a social and an economic infrastructure. 675 microfiche.
- **Assyriology / Egyptology.** Rare serials and monographs on the civilizations of the Ancient Near East. Topics include archaeology, art, languages, law and religions of Sumeria, Babylonia, Assyria, Egypt and other ancient cultures of the Fertile Crescent. 13,531 microfiche.
- **Palestine: The Legal Background.** A collection of sources from the collection "Law in the Service of Man", Ramallah. The collection contains source material on the legal status of the Occupied Territories in Israel from the period of the Ottoman empire until the June 1967 war, when Israeli forces occupied the West Bank and Gaza strip. 23 titles. 1,313 microfiche.
