- **CHRIST CHURCH, OXFORD: THE EARLY PRINTED MUSIC COLLECTION**
Over 650 volumes of printed texts from the 16th and 17th centuries are included in this collection. 76 reels on 35mm microfilm.
- **WESTMINSTER ABBEY LIBRARY EARLY PRINTED AND MANUSCRIPT MUSIC**
The majority of this collection is choral music. Much of the printed music is Italian, mostly of the 17th century. There is also a good collection of secular works. The manuscript music, which makes up a third of the series, is mostly from the 18th century. 32 reels on 35mm microfilm.
- **LINCOLN CATHEDRAL LIBRARY MUSIC COLLECTION, 17th-19th CENTURIES**
Each manuscript from this collection is a unique performing copy of a choral part-book. 60 reels on 35mm microfilm.
- **THE BROADWOOD ARCHIVES, THE BUSINESS RECORDS OF JOHN BROADWOOD & SONS, PIANO-MAKERS, 1794-1901, with the Lucy Broadwood Folksong Archive.** The Broadwood company ledgers contain over 100 years of extensive records of clients and business associates. The Folksong Archive can be purchased separately. 95 reels on 35mm microfilm.
