- **British Intelligence on the North-West Frontier**, 1901-1949. Indian Office Political and Secret Reports on Tribes and Terrorism. The materials in this collection document the British attempts to impose 'order' on the tribal territories. With details of policy initiatives familiar to contemporary observers of the region, the files describe imperial struggles with jihadist movements, and show how local leaders were able to stay out of British hands. The material covers the period 1901 to 1949, from the creation of the 'North-West Frontier Province' to 1949, by which time the Province had become an administrative region of Pakistan. 343 fiches or 33 reels

- **Times of India**. Covers 1861-1889. Formed in 1861 by the merger of the 'Bombay Times', the 'Standard' and the 'Telegraph', it aspired to be a paper of national importance, becoming one of Asia's leading dailies. 92 reels
- **India News**. Covers 1949-1961. Weekly newspaper published in London. From the High Commission of India, London. 162 reels
- **The Pioneer** (Allahabad) Covers 1870-1888. The daily *par excellence* of British society in Allahabad, India, having close ties with officials and well known for having advance information on changes in government policies. 13 reels
- **Calcutta Government Gazette**. Covers 1815-1832. A newspaper which enjoyed the exclusive privilege of publishing Government orders and notifications by authority. 27 reels. **\*\*\*Available at a Special Price\*\*\***

- India News. Covers 1949-1961. Weekly newspaper published in London. From High Commission of India, London. 3 reels
- The Comrade. Covers 1913-1914. Published in Delhi, India. 2 reels
- The India Gazette. Covers 1782-1788, 1822-1840, 1842-1843. Published in Calcutta. Begun as a rival to Hicky's Bengal Gazette. It was used as a medium for publishing official advertisements and became particularly influential under the editorship of Dr. John Grant, 1822-29. 46 reels
